Hi Gordon,

One further query, we understand that a Pollution Prevention and Control (PPC) permit will be required to undertake the intended decommissioning activities at the site due to 'the recovery of hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 10 tonnes per day' and 'the recovery of non-hazardous waste with a capacity exceeding 75 tonnes per day'. To help gauge the suitability of the site for this activity and any potential for impacts on the adjacent SSSI, have SEPA offered a view on the likelihood of PPC permit being issued for this activity?

Any clarification that you can provide on this point would be much appreciated.
