

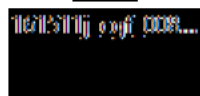

**SCREENING OPINION UNDER PART 2, REGULATION 11 OF THE MARINE WORKS (ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT) REGULATIONS 2007**

**Clydeport and Arch Henderson :** Proposed Upgrade and Extension to Existing Quay on North of Construction Yard and Associated Dredging.



I have recently received a proposal from Enviro-Centre (see attached) for a Proposed Upgrade and Extension to the Existing Quay on North of Construction Yard and Associated Dredging at the Hunterston Construction Yard in the Clydeport Harbour area. Elements of the project will require licensing under Part IV of the Marine (Scotland) Act 2010.
