Dear [Redacted],

Thank you for your call yesterday. We understand that later this week (before the lapse of the agreed determination period on Friday) you will write to us outlining what further information you require to reach a decision. It is also understood that any clarification or further information you deem necessary relates to hydrodynamics and piling/marine mammals. In your communication to us can you please be as prescriptive as possible so that on provision of further information to you that there are no further iterations. We will also have to agree a new determination date, can you confirm what timescale you will need to consider our additional information once received.

Having spoken to our Clients I would summarise their response as follows:

1. They are extremely disappointed at the lack of momentum and consider that there has been adequate time within which to request additional data, prior to now;
2. They intend to take the matter up with the Minister responsible; and
3. They do not agree that the project is complicated or complex and that reluctance in making a decision is purely down to 'public interest' as noted in your previous correspondence.

In relation to point 3 above we would agree that this is not a complex project and it is not fundamentally different to that previously screened negatively.

We will respond further once we have received the letter you have indicated will be issued this week.
